Purpose of the Organization: The Humane Society of Western Montana has been serving western Montana since 1963. HSWM is an open admission shelter (accepting all animals), and guarantees placement of all behaviorally sound animals. About 1500 animals find refuge and care each year at the shelter.

HSWM is a private, non-profit organization supported solely by private donations, fundraising events, and grants. We don't receive government funding or income from any larger organization like the Humane Society of the United States.

Purpose of the Event: The goal of this year's Ken Shughart Humanitarian Award is to raise \$45,000 to \$50,000 for our annual fund. The annual fund supports the shelter's existing programs and services including:

- Housing, healthy food, and medical care for 1500 animals annually
- Training and grooming for shelter animals
- Foster care supplies for H.O.P.E foster care program
- Humane education programs for area school children
- Spay/neuter surgeries for shelter animals and the public
- Free pet behavior advice for the public
- Companion animal lost and found service
- Micro-chipping and dog licensing
- Special programs for senior citizens and senior pets
