Reuniting/Rehoming a Stray Pet

- The Humane Society of Western Montana accepts stray pets as resources are available. Please contact the shelter at 406-549-3934 for more information or to leave a lost or found pet report.
- Missoula Animal Control accepts stray cats and dogs from Missoula County.
- Bitterroot Humane Association accepts stray cats and dogs from Ravalli County.
- The Missoulian offers free classified advertisement for lost and found pets.
- Lost and found reports can be posted with the Humane Society of Western Montana and other area animal shelters, Craigslist and most radio stations.
- The Humane Society of Western Montana offers a free template for creating a lost or found flyer; these can be posted at grocery stores, veterinary offices, traffic intersections, local animal shelters, etc.

Rehoming an Owned Pet

- Get rid of the problem, not your pet! The Humane Society offers a free behavior helpline, dog training classes, a behavior resource list. We also have available advice on managing pet allergies and pets and new babies.

- Contact other area shelters for suggestions and rehoming options.
- Consider researching rescue options. The Humane Society may be able to refer a rescue that would be able to help you rehome your pet.
